

Fallingwater – Frank Lloyd Wright

Fallingwater was first created in 1935 by Frank Lloyd Wright. It is a simple house with an open living room originally built on a waterfall in Southwestern Pennsylvania. Once completed it was listed in 'Smithsonian's' Life List of 28 Places to visit. It was a weekend home for Liliane Kaufmann and her husband Edgar J. Kaufmann until he donated the home to the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy. The original estimated cost for Fallingwater was \$35,000 (£24,829). The final cost for the house and guest house was \$155,000 (£109, 957).
