

Results of the Parent Questionnaire 2023

We received responses from 68 parents and carers of our 100 pupils. This is a significant improvement from 31 in 2019, the last questionnaire undertaken before COVID disruption. We will seek to further improve the level of responses in 2024.

Highlights

The overall impression is that parents and carers are very positive in their assessment of Chadlington Primary. Most felt their children are happy going to school, the teaching is good, and their suggestions and concerns were important to staff. In addition, children enjoy a varied and interesting curriculum, and the creative approach helps them to make good progress. Parents are proud to send their children to Chadlington, believe they are safe, and feel the school is a welcoming and pleasant place to visit.

Some areas were highlighted for potential improvement. These include the effectiveness of dealing with unacceptable behaviour, the range of activities and clubs on offer, and the frequency of information about children's progress. The breakdown of responses for each question is shown in the table attached.

Parents were also asked to provide comments and suggestions relating to their responses, particularly when they disagreed with any of the statements. These comments were very useful and have been analysed and grouped into topics for discussion by the governing board, from which an action plan will be created. The key points include:

Aspects of school life that parents particularly like (summary of the themes)

- Lots going on for a small school with limited resources
- A friendly and nurturing environment
- Fosters a passion for learning
- Good support for specific needs
- Children are happy
- Culture of creative learning
- Children are encouraged to be empathetic and supportive of each other
- Exciting range of school trips and projects

Suggestions

- More regular progress updates
- A wider range of school clubs
- Better range of sport
- Improve road safety. Stop parking on Zig Zag and double yellow lines
- No smoking by school gates
- Improve quality of school meals; meat-free days
- Further preparation for secondary school
- System for sharing second-hand uniform
- More space for play and exercise
